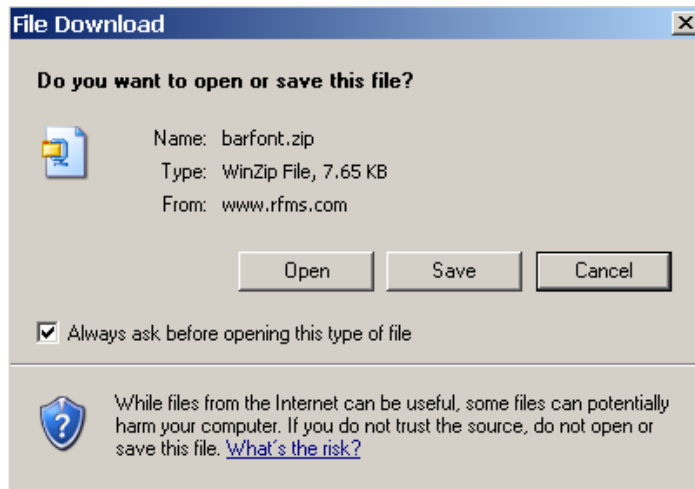




Downloading, Installing & Testing the 3of 9 Bar Code fonts

NOTE: (The following process works when using WINZIP. If WINZIP is not installed, go to <http://www.winzip.com/>.)

1. Close out of all RFMS modules and go to www.rfms.com.
2. Click on Program Downloads. Enter a username and password at this time.
3. Click on Barfont.zip. The following screen will display.



4. Open the file or save the zip file to open later.
5. Upon opening this zip file, three font files will be listed.

6. Select all three of these files. They will need to be extracted from this zip file into the Fonts folder.
7. Once all three files are selected, click the Extract button. Select the path to which to save these files.
8. To get to the Font Folder do the following:
 - a. Link the path to the Font folder by selecting the Local C: Drive.
 - b. Select the Windows folder.
 - c. Within the Windows folder see a folder called Fonts. Select the Font folder and click the Extract button.

Testing for Fonts

To test to make sure the 3 of 9 bar code font is correctly installed, do the following:

1. Go to **Start>Programs>Accessories>Word Pad**. Click on the dropdown list in the Font field.
2. The **3 of 9 Barcode** Font should be the first in the list. If not, please repeat steps 1-8, reading the instructions carefully.
